- c. <u>Required Disclosure.</u> Each Party may disclose the other Party's Confidential Information when required by law and must notify the other party of such disclosure.

COURSERA PROVIDES ITS PRODUCTS AND SERVICES "AS IS" AND DOES NOT WARRANT THAT THE OPERATION OF ITS PRODUCTS AND SERVICES WILL BE ERRORFREE OR UNINTERRUPTED. - j. Amendments. Any amendment must be in writing and expressly state that it is amending this Order Form. The enforceability, terms and conditions of this Agreement shall not be affected, amended or superseded by the issuance or acceptance of a purchase order delivered for the Services that are the subject of this Agreement.
