Objective:

The One Red Ribbon Peer Leaders Convention aimed to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS and promote safe sexual practices among students. The event sought to engage young leaders in spreading accurate information about HIV prevention and encourage them to become advocates for health and well-being within their communities.

Description:

On 22nd March 2024, the National Service Scheme (NSS)Unit participated in the One Red Ribbon Peer Leaders Convention held at Kakatiya University, Hanumakonda. The convention took place from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM and witnessed 53 participants, including NSS volunteers and Staff.

The convention included the following activities:

- **Awareness Sessions:** Experts and health professionals led discussions on HIV/AIDS, focusing on prevention, stigma reduction, and the importance of safe sexual practices.
- Peer Leader Training: Participants were trained to become peer leaders, equipped
 with the knowledge and tools to educate their peers on HIV prevention and promote
 awareness within their communities.
- **Interactive Activities:** Various activities and games were conducted to engage participants while reinforcing the messages of the convention in an interactive manner.

Outcome:

Participants gained in-depth knowledge about HIV/AIDS, including prevention methods and how to combat the stigma surrounding the disease. The convention also empowered students to take on leadership roles, training them to become peer educators who could spread awareness and facilitate discussions on HIV prevention. Impact on Society:


