Report on One Red Ribbon Peer Leaders Convention

Objective:

The One Red Ribbon Peer Leaders Convention aimed to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS and promote safe sexual practices among students. The event sought to engage young leaders in spreading accurate information about HIV prevention and encourage them to become advocates for health and well-being within their communities.

Description:
