Objective:

The objective of the program was to raise awareness among the public about road safety rules, particularly the importance of wearing helmets while riding two-wheelers. The campaign aimed to encourage responsible behavior on roads and reduce traffic-related injuries and fatalities.

Description:

On 2nd October 2024, the NSS Unit of SR University organized a Traffic Awareness Program at Pochammaidan Junction from 10:30 AM to 12:00 PM. Under the guidance of Dr. K. Ravindar, NSS Program Coordinator, 15 student volunteers actively took part in the campaign.

Volunteers engaged with commuters and pedestrians, distributed informative pamphlets, and educated two-wheeler riders about the necessity of wearing helmets for their own safety. The students held placards and displayed slogans promoting safe driving practices. Some volunteers interacted directly with individuals who were not following traffic rules, advising them respectfully and creating awareness.

Outcome:

The program generated positive responses from the public and helped reinforce the importance of helmet usage and road discipline. Volunteers gained experience in public interaction and advocacy for social causes.

Impact on Society:

This awareness campaign played a role in promoting safer road practices and civic responsibility. By directly engaging with the community, the NSS volunteers contributed to reducing risky behavior on roads and potentially saving lives.
