### **Objectives of the Program:**

1. To create awareness about fire hazards and safety procedures.
2. To educate volunteers on fire classification and extinguishing methods.
3. To provide hands-on training in using fire extinguishers and rescue tools.
4. To develop emergency preparedness and evacuation skills among students.
5. To introduce disaster management systems handled by SDRF and NDRF.

### **Program Description:**

The resource persons explained the fundamental concepts of fire, types of fires, and the importance of responding swiftly during emergencies. A live demonstration of extinguishers and rescue equipment was conducted, giving volunteers practical exposure to real-life emergency handling.

Volunteers also learned about the Triangle of Fire (Heat – Fuel – Oxygen) and how breaking any element can extinguish fire.

### Types of Fire & Extinguishing Agents

Class	Type of Fire	Example	Extinguishing Method
Class A	Solids	Wood, Cloth, Paper	Water
Class B	Liquids	Petrol, Diesel, Paint	Sand, Foam
Class C	Gas	LPG, CNG	CO <sub>2</sub> or ABC Extinguisher
Class D	Metal	Magnesium, Aluminum	Special Powder

### SRU NSS Unit Conducts Fire Safety Drill at Warangal Fire Station

**(Capital Information)**  
**(Mufugu) Warangal, November 15:** The SRU NSS Unit organised a comprehensive Fire Safety Drill and Demonstration Programme at the Warangal Fire Station on Saturday, aimed at sensitising NSS volunteers to fire hazards, emergency response techniques, and disaster management preparedness.

The session was led by Fire Officer Sridhar Reddy, who attended the event as Chief Guest. He was accompanied by senior personnel including Leading Fireman M. Ganesh, Driver Operator P. Sunilrider, and Fireman S. Narendar. Sathish, Ms. Shahid Partha, and Ekshapathi.

As part of the demonstration, officials explained the functioning of the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) and the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), highlighting their critical role in handling natural and man-made disasters.

**Key Topics Covered**  
 Fire officers presented a detailed explanation of types of fires:  
 Class A (Solids) – Vector  
 Class B (Liquids) – Sand or Foam  
 Class C (Gases) – CO<sub>2</sub> or ABC extinguishers  
 Class D (Metals) – Specialised methods

Volunteers were trained in operating CO<sub>2</sub> and ABC fire extinguishers, and were briefed on the Triangle of Fire – Heat, Fuel, and Oxygen – essential for understanding fire behaviour.

**Equipment Demonstrated**  
 The Fire Department showcased a wide range of fire and rescue equipment, including Water Tender, Rescue Boat with life-saving gear, Breathing Apparatus (BA Set), Multi-Gas Detector, Rescue Lines, Cutting and Entry Tools, Chemical Protective Suits, Scoop, Stretcher, Spine Boards, Rope Ladders, Megaphones, Chain Saws, Pneumatic Lifting Airbags, Victim Location Camera, and Traffic Warning Bats.

Emergency numbers – 101 for Fire Services and 112 for National Emergencies – were reiterated for public awareness.

NSS volunteers actively participated in hands-on drills, practised using fire extinguishers, and learned step-by-step procedures for safe evacuation and rescue operations.

The programme was conducted under the supervision of Dr. K. Ravindar, NSS Coordinator and Associate Physical Director at SR University.
