Alongside, an awareness session on women's health, hygiene, and nutrition was conducted for the local community, with active interaction between experts, teachers, and villagers.

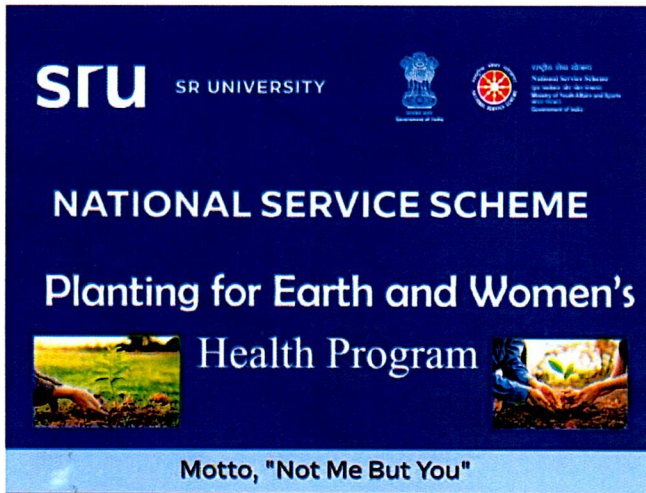
Outcome:
