SR University – NSS Unit Conducts Dengue & Malaria Awareness Drive




(Capital information) Warangal, Mulugu, February 27 : The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of SR University organized a Dengue and Malaria Prevention Awareness Programme on Thursday at Yellapur Village and the 67th Division, in coordination with the local Primary Health Centre (PHC). Medical personnel from the PHC addressed villagers on the causes, symptoms, treatment, and preventive measures related to Dengue and Malaria. They emphasized that both diseases are transmitted through mosquito bites and underscored the need for maintaining clean and hygienic surroundings to curb their spread. During the programme, NSS volunteers and PHC staff sensitized residents on key preventive measures, including: Preventing stagnation of water in and around households; Regular cleaning of water storage containers and air coolers; Use of mosquito nets, coils, and repellents; Wearing full-sleeved clothing to minimize mosquito exposure; Ensuring proper sanitation and scientific waste disposal; The medical team further advised that individuals experiencing symptoms such as high fever, severe headache, joint and body pains, nausea, chills, or weakness should immediately seek medical attention at the nearest Primary Health Centre rather than resorting to self-medication. Villagers actively participated in the awareness drive and expressed appreciation to the NSS Unit and PHC staff for their timely initiative and health guidance. The programme was conducted under the supervision of NSS Programme Officers, with enthusiastic participation from NSS volunteers and the full support of the PHC medical team, said Dr. Ravindar K, NSS Coordinator, SR University.
